# 4.0 New Device Registration Code Management

## 4.1 Create A New Device Registration Code

The purpose of this function is to enable the user to create a Registration Code for designating a Computer/Device as a Registered Device to access **allianceonline PERSONAL** services.

### Device Registration Code




Figure 2.7: Create New Device Registration Code

You can access **allianceonline PERSONAL** from more than one registered computer/device. From the GRID Device Management main page (Figure 2.5), Click the **Create** button to create a new device registration code. The Code created is to be used to register a new Computer/Device for allianceonline access. This page (Figure 2.7) shows the registration information needed for new device registration code. After filling in the necessary info, Click on submit request to store the Code for later use.

**Step 1:** Key in a name in the device label field

You may name the Device with any label you wish for reference to the computer/Device you register later using this Registration Code.  
e.g. Home PC, My Laptop etc

**Step 2:** Select the Type of device to be permanent or temporary.

**Permanent** means the Device is a permanently registered device to access to your allianceonline service. If you decide not to have access from this Device in the future, it requires Revoking of the Device from the list as per steps.

**Temporary** means you grant access to your allianceonline service with this Device until the date as specified in the valid field. You are required to fill in the expiry date for this device if you select the Temporary Type.

**Step 3:** Key in a registration code known to you.

You may input any combination of alphanumeric up to 6 characters as the Registration Code.

After completion of information, click on the **Submit Request** button to store the information. Once the Request is completed, Registration Code Request Status screen will show as on 4.2 below

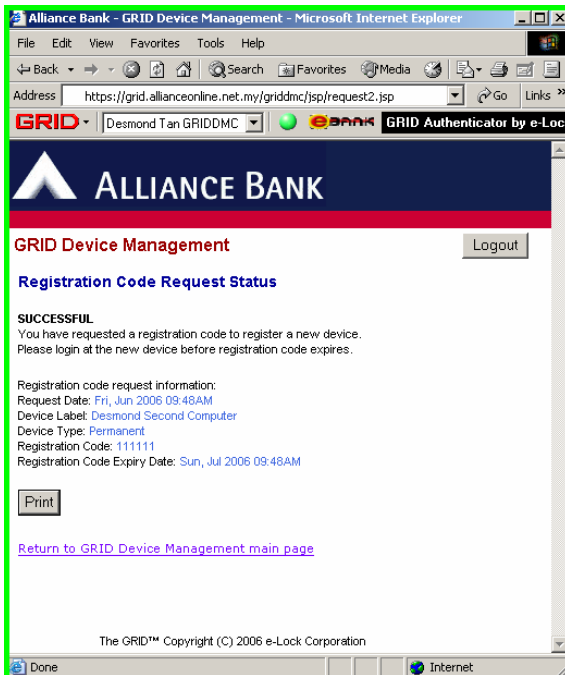


Figure 2.8: Request Status

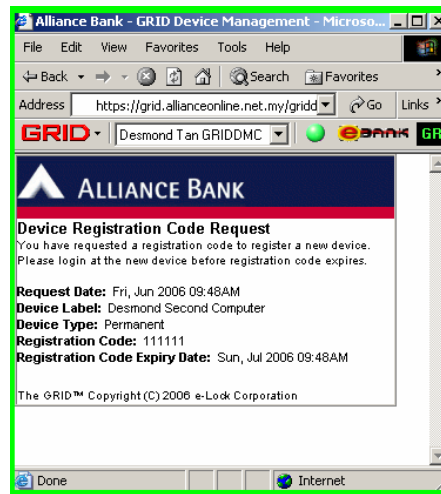



Figure 2.9: Print Out

Figure 2.8 will show if your request for registration code to register new computer/device is successful.

If you decide to print the Registration Code information for reference, click the **Print** button, a prompted page as in Figure 2.9 with "Are you sure you want to print this page?" will appear. Click on the OK button and a credit-card size formatted page will be printed out. (Please ensure your printer is turn on).

After you have created a new device registration code, the **Device Registration Code** pane will list the pending code ready for registration. The **Create** button will not be shown when there is a code pending for device registration. You can have only one Device Registration Code pending at any time. You may choose to delete the pending code. Select the pending Device Registration Code and Click on the Delete Code button.
